## Height and weight checks for children in Year 6

### What we need for you to do:

Complete the electronic consent form with either **Yes** or **No**  
(please read this letter for further information)

Even if you do not wish your child to be measured, please complete the e-consent form so we can record your preference.

- Enter your school's unique code: - **SR136338**
- Complete the boxes

Each year in England, school children in Year 6 have their height and weight checked at school as part of the National Child Measurement Programme. Height and weight measurements are used to calculate weight status. During the autumn term members of the school nursing team weigh and measure children fully clothed, except for their coats and shoes, in a private space away from other pupils.

To carry out these checks we need to have your consent, which is captured electronically.

E-consent is quick and easy and can be completed on any device i.e., mobile phone, tablet, or computer.

Children do not have to take part on the day if they do not want to.

An automated email will be sent to you on completion of the e-consent form from Cinnamon Digital Applications (who host the website for us). This email can sometimes be sent to the junk folder, so please check. If you do not receive any results within 10 working days of the screening, please contact the Surrey wide 0-19 Advice Line on 01883 340922.

We will be sending your child's measurements to you using the email address you enter via the e-consent form. Please note that if your child is a healthy weight there will be no further contact from the School Nursing team.
