Working to raise funds for Cleves School

We are approaching the end of another school year! Considering much of the year's fundraising events were still affected by covid, an amazing **£14,000** has been raised for Cleves School since September.

In the Spring term, multi days helped raise an additional **£1,000** and over **£6,000** has been raised so far from class fundraising.

We've also received **£258** from participation in the Elmbridge Lottery, Amazon Smile and Easy Fundraising.

What will happen to the money raised?

In addition to the information shared in the previous newsletter, money has been promised to the school (£40k over a 2 year period - £25k now and 15k next year) for an exciting project in the playground. The area outside the Year 6 block will become a multipurpose space - for play, quiet area and for lessons. This is a major project which will benefit the children enormously. Whilst we are waiting on the outcome of planning permission, we are hopeful for this to be completed for the start of next school year.
