## Y5 Residential Trip - Isle of Wight 2022 - £368

Firstly, if your child does not want to attend the residential trip please could you kindly let us know by filling in the appropriate portion of the reply form overleaf.

Once again the children in Y5 have the opportunity to participate in a residential visit to the PGL Little Canada Adventure Centre on the Isle of Wight. This is a very popular visit which provides a very diverse programme, consisting of curriculum studies and adventure pursuits. We will visit Freshwater Bay where the children will be able to study and extend their understanding of the effects of coastal erosion, linked to the Landforms topic we study in the summer term. In addition, they will have the opportunity to challenge themselves through experiencing activities such as abseiling, sensory trails and collaborative climbing activities. We will also enjoy evening activities such as a campfire and a disco!

The trip will take place from Tuesday 10th May - Friday 13th May 2022 at a cost of £368.

The children will stay in purpose-built chalet-style accommodation, most with adjoining Teacher/adult rooms. All food will be provided by the centre for the duration of our visit and will cater for all dietary requirements. The children will need a packed lunch from home on the first day.

The activities will be based outdoors so children will need to bring clothes that you do not mind getting muddy or wet. If you are having a clear out before May, you might want to keep old clothing for the trip!

The trip will cost £368. We would ask <u>Free School Meal registered</u> children, or if you have <u>other extenuating circumstances</u>, to contact Mrs Poole, jpoole@cleves.co.uk, so that a payment plan can be discussed, <u>before the 21st October</u>. The school believes wholeheartedly in the value of educational visits and opportunities, however we unfortunately do not have the financial resources to pay the full costs. Consequently, a voluntary contribution is requested from parents/carers. If we do not receive enough contributions then we will cancel this trip. Please regard this as an important investment in your child's education.

We strongly encourage you to use the online payment system, which is for your convenience and ours. If you cannot contribute online then cheques should be payable to 'Cleves School' and must have the child's name, class and 'Y5 Res Trips' written on the back. Cash must be in a sealed envelope, marking it 'Y5 Res Trip' and your child's name and class written on it. Any contributions and/or return forms should be put in the 'Drop Box' which is situated between the front double doors at reception. The whole sheet and/or contribution should be returned by Thursday 21st October 2021.

If you do not contribute the deposit by the 21st October, or have not contacted Mrs Poole, we shall assume your child will <u>NOT</u> be attending the trip and will remove them from the booking.

If you would like to contribute in instalments (all contributions are non-refundable as we have to pay deposits and instalments to the accommodation in advance of the trip), please adhere to the following:

Could we kindly request you contribute these on (or before) the due date as it is very time consuming to send out reminders for contributions. You are welcome to contribute as much as you can whenever you can, as long as you meet the instalment deadline.

We recognise that some parents may have already paid for a percentage of the trip, if this is the case please continue to pay the balance in-line with the payment programme above.

If you would like to be considered as an Adult Helper on the trip, please review the important points of information below and fill out the appropriate section of the sheet attached and return with your child's deposit.

- All adults on the trip must be DBS checked. This must be in place 4 weeks before the trip and sometimes takes 6 8 weeks to process.
- You must have completed the Safeguarding Induction with Mr Thomas.
- If you volunteer to accompany the trip, it must be a <u>firm commitment</u> as dropping out may jeopardise the trip for the entire year group.
- You will be 'In Loco Parentis' potentially 24/7 for the duration of the trip. You will be required from 'wake up' until 'bedtime' and perhaps even during the night! Some activities will require Adult Help participation. Please be aware that we need volunteers to engage fully in the successful running of the trip. It is very tiring and you must be reasonably fit!
- You will <u>not</u> be with your child unless there is a strong medical reason for doing so. You may not be on the same coach, however, you will most likely see them at some point during the trip.
- It includes travel to and from Cleves and the Isle of Wight.
- It is hugely rewarding accompanying a residential trip. To see the children first hand away from the school environment is both interesting and enjoyable.

Please respect the teacher's professional judgment in choosing which adults will accompany the trip. There are many different factors that have to be taken into consideration.

More information regarding the trip will be given out nearer the time but if you have any queries or questions in the meantime, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher or Mrs Poole.
