Labelled bin bag for wet and dirty clothing.

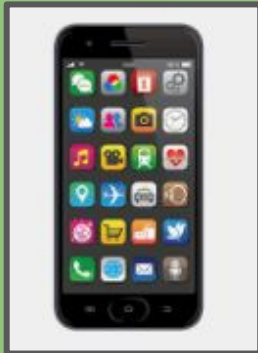


Please **DO NOT** bring...


